Substantive Law and Legal Analysis

Bar Candidates rarely fail the Bar Examination because they are weak in their knowledge of the substantive law. After several years of law school, most students command sufficient legal knowledge in the areas of substantive law tested on examination situationals. Online Home Study Program

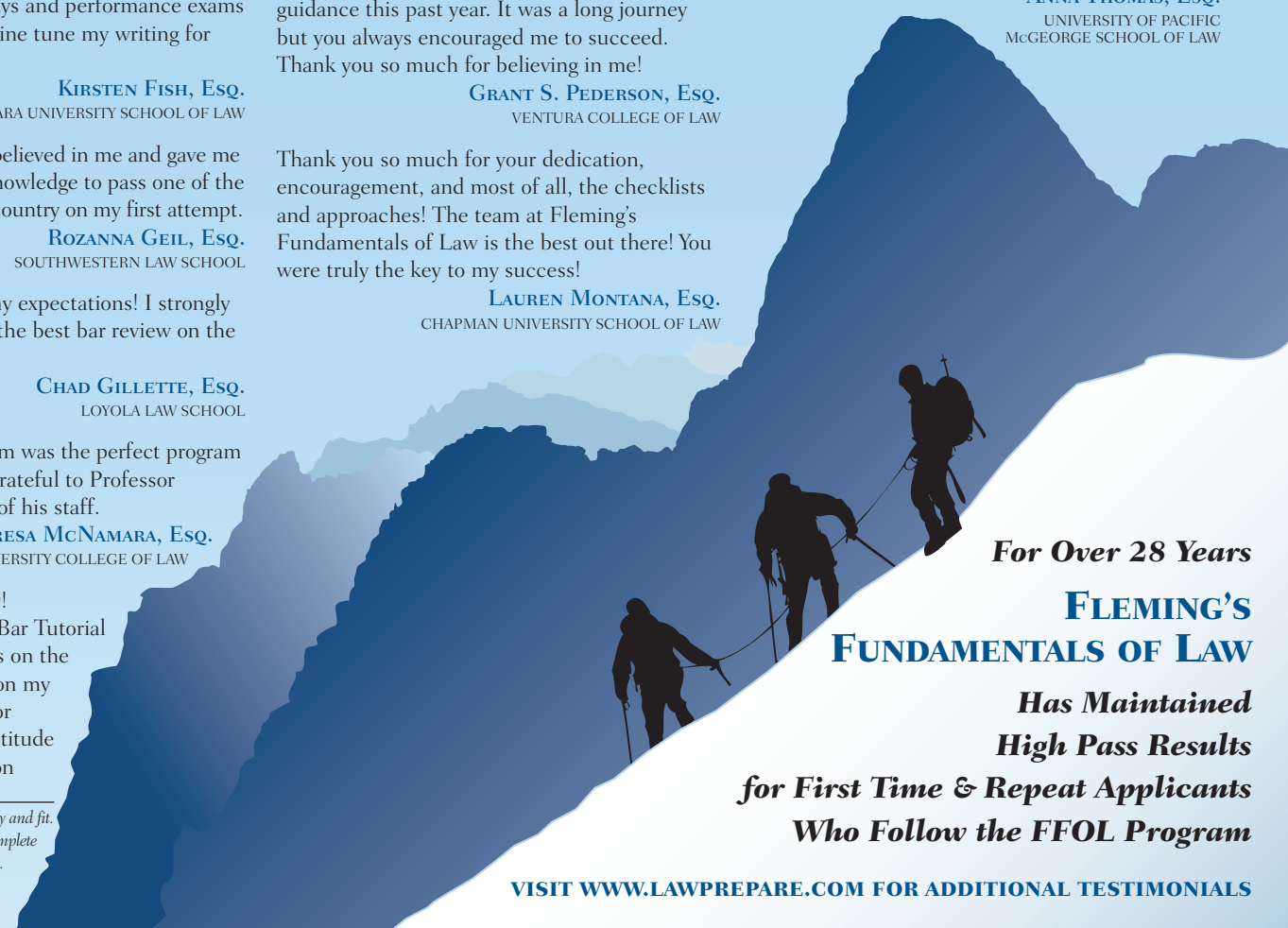
