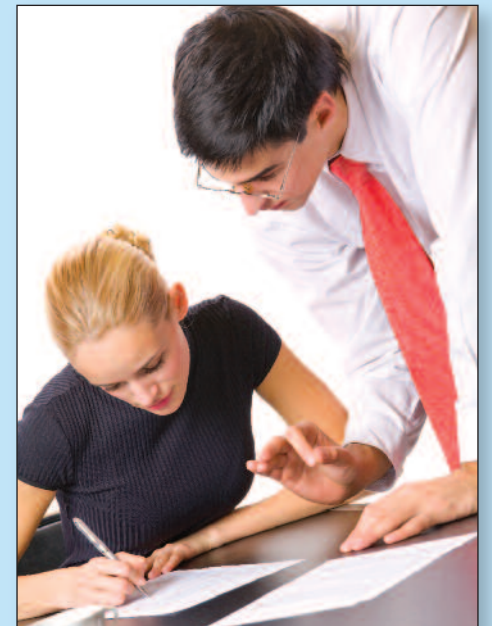

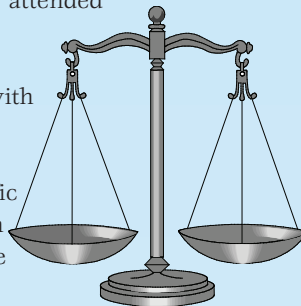
• Professor Patricia L. Andel, Esq.
